

Set up your space for home dialysis

Ready to prepare your space for home dialysis? Your care team is here to help! They will work with you to find ways to store all your supplies.

Try these tips to organize your space:



Look at stacking higher, as well as wider.

Depending on your space, you may be able to stack some supplies on top of each other as long as they're stable and don't go over the height of your shoulders.



Maximize unused storage space.

Try sliding supplies under beds or stacking them in closets, out of sight.



Stash small supplies in movable storage.

Plastic stacking drawers on wheels can hold small supplies—and be moved out of the way when not in use.



Order fewer supplies at a time.

Having one month of supplies on hand is ideal. However, it is possible to have smaller, more frequent deliveries.



Take what you can out of boxes.

Some supplies have to remain boxed if you want to return what you don't use. Smaller items can be removed to cut down on volume.
